

The City of St. John is working with Republic Services to try and help residents affected by the recent flooding to dispose of their items that were ruined by flood waters. In order to help determine the best way for everyone, we are asking impacted residents to call City Hall (314-427-8700, ext. 3) and answer the following questions:

- 1) Your name, address & phone number**
- 2) How were you impacted by the floods: (i.e. flooding in home, garage, roof leaked, etc.)**
- 3) What type of items and approximately how many items do you have to get rid of?**
- 4) Of the following two options, what do you feel would be the best way for you to dispose of your ruined items:**
 - Put items out at the curb of your home for Republic Services to pick up on a pre-determined day(s)? or**
 - Take items to a dumpster which the City could provide on a City lot and you could just throw them in the dumpster?**

Please keep in mind that no appliances, electronic items or hazardous waste items can be picked up by the trash trucks or emptied into a dumpster.
